## Commencement Check List for Undergraduate Students

Here is a handy list to ensure that you are taking all the steps you need to get ready for your big day!

Register to officially graduate and receive your diploma with the Office of the Registrar. (January 17, 2023 - March 10, 2023)
<b>Register to participate in the commencement ceremonies</b> . Do this as soon as possible because ceremony date availability is first-come, first served. (March 1 - May 23)
<b>Plan with friends and family.</b> Share the <u>"plan your visit" page</u> with your family to start booking hotels, flights and ground travel.
Read through the commencement FAQs.
Attend Grad Fair. (Friday, April 14, 10 am 2 p.m.) The fun event takes place at the Memorial Union North Courtyard outside of the Campus Store.
Secure your cap and gown rental. (March 1-April 23)  A price increase (+\$15) will start April 24. Last day to order online is May 23 at 9pm — limited emergency gowns will be available during distribution, please inquire at Memorial Union Campus Store lower level if emergency rental is needed.
Reach out to your college commencement coordinator for accessibility assistance or help of any kind. <a href="https://www.ucdavis.edu/commencement/contact">https://www.ucdavis.edu/commencement/contact</a>
If you want to <u>purchase custom announcements</u> , order now.  They take approximately 3 weeks to arrive.
Purchase your (optional) <u>stole</u> and any honors cords from the bookstore.  Stoles look real good in photos and unlike the gown, you get to keep it.
Book and take graduation photos on campus.  Check out #UCDavisGrad on Instagram for inspiration on poses and campus locations.  Please do not use any glitter/confetti - it hurts our wildlife!

Register for Pro Pics - the photography vendor who will be on site taking grad stage photos. UC Davis has partnered with Pro Pics to take professional portraits of all graduates during the ceremony. Photos will be available for purchase after the ceremony. There is no cost to have your photo taken and no obligation to purchase. Register in advance at www.UCDavisphotos.com.
<b>Keep checking your email for critical updates.</b> If you missed any emails they are all posted <a href="here">here</a> .
<b>Reserve Your Golden 1 Center parking pass through SacPark.</b> (Now thru the day before your ceremony)
Plan out your outfit and plan for comfortable shoes.
Share the live stream link with your friends and family who won't be coming in person.  Live links will be available on the Commencement homepage closer to the events and will be streamed on-demand on the UC Davis YouTube page and at our Commencement Archives.
Pick up cap and gown rental from the campus Bookstore. (May 24 - June 17)
Decorate your graduation cap and enter it in the <u>UC Davis Grad Cap Contest</u> for a chance to win prizes. (May - June).
A few days prior to your big day

Print or have downloaded to mobile phones.</li> <li>□ Plan drop off with your family/friends.
