

Starting June 10th Stebbins Cold Canyon trails are NOW OPEN with new COVID-19 safety precautions in place

Please be aware that we are in the middle of high heat and low humidity conditions; limit your time on the trail to the cooler morning hours. Check National Weather Service updates for red flag conditions (<https://www.fire.ca.gov/programs/communications/red-flag-warnings-fire-weather-watches/>) and avoid hiking at those times. Trails may close again if county-wide COVID-19 restrictions return.

- We suggest you wear a mask and maintain 6 feet separation from other trail users. Use hand sanitizer or wipes if you touch commonly touched surfaces.
- Because of COVID-19 safety precautions we had to remove the portable restroom. There is no bathroom or water on site.
- Please pack out anything you bring in.
- No dogs are allowed on these trails, other trails nearby allow dogs.
- Bring more water than you think you will need. We recommend a gallon if you plan to hike the Blue Ridge Trail.
- Summer is rattlesnake season, pay attention!
- Be aware poison oak is found along the trail.
